Unifor to organize strike votes for DHL members to strengthen the bargaining committee's position against an intransigent employer.

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Unifor Local 922 members at Nutrien have ratified a new contract with wage increases and benefit improvements.

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Unifor Local 27 members at General Dynamics vote 97% in favour of a new three-year contract that covers more than 480 workers at the London, Ont. plant.

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NS health care Nova Scotia's Health Support workers file for conciliation after reaching impasse over wages.

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
